

Information clause

Pursuant to Art. 13, paragraph 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individual persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (hereinafter: "EU GDPR [*Pol. RODO*]"), we hereby inform that:

1. The University of Łódź, located at 68 Narutowicza Street, 90-136 Łódź, is the controller of your personal data (hereinafter: "Controller");

3. Your providing us with your personal data will serve the following purposes:
 - 1) all types of activities related to the organization of the guest Lecture: "Prosecuting Fraud in the Metropolis, 1760-1820: Some Reflections on Researching Historical Financial Crime" organized at the Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Łódź, hereinafter referred to as: "the Lecture"/ Seminar: 'Criminal Enforcement and White-Collar Crime' organized at the Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Łódź, hereinafter referred to as: "the Seminar"
 - 2) *publication of your image on websites (including social media Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, LinkedIn) owned by the Organizer of the Lecture/Seminar (Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Lodz) and partners**;The legal basis for processing of the data is Art. 6, paragraph 1, point (a), Art. 9, paragraph 1, point (a), of the EU GDPR (i.e. your informed consent to the processing of your personal data);
Providing your data is voluntary, but necessary for the achievement of the goals specified in point (3).
4. The following personal data will be processed: name, surname, e-mail address, *image**.
5. Your personal data will be made available to persons authorized by the Controller and involved in the organization of the Lecture/Seminar and persons authorized to obtain personal data in accordance with the law.
6. With regard to the processing of data for the purposes specified in point (3), sub-point (1) and (2)* your personal data will not be transferred to a third country / international organization, unless it is required by the Controller's legal obligations.
7. *With regard to the processing of data for the purpose specified in point (3), sub-point (2) your personal data will be transferred to a third country**.
8. Your personal data will be processed and stored for a period not exceeding that necessary for the purpose set out in clause 3 point 1 but not longer than beyond the deadline required by the office and archival instruction and by the uniform material list of files of University of Lodz.
9. *Your personal data will be processed and stored for the period necessary to achieve the aim specified in point (3), sub-point (2) or until you withdraw your consent**.
10. *You have the right to access your personal data and the right to demand rectification, erasure of personal data (where legally permissible), restriction of processing, portability of the data; the right to raise objection, and the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.*
11. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory body, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, should you decide that the processing of personal data concerning your person violates the provisions of the EU GDPR;
12. It is not envisaged that personal data should be processed for purposes other than the purpose for which personal data were collected;
13. With regard to the implementation of the objectives specified in point (3), sub-points (1) and (2), your personal data will not be processed in an automated manner, including profiling.
14. With regard to the implementation of the objectives specified in point (3), sub-point (3), your personal data may be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling referred to in Art. 22 (1) and (4) of EU GDPR*;
