## BERLIN FIELD TRIP – INCLUSIVE

The first weekend will take us to Berlin. The trip to Germany's capital city will invite you to have a look behind the scenes of the major political institution in Germany: The German "Bundestag". We will also visit the "Brandenburger Tor" and the remains of the Berlin Wall. A city tour by bus will take you to the most important historical attractions and cultural places all over the city. Of course, there will be time to discover Berlin and its countless attractions on your own. On Sunday, before we arrive back in Giessen, we'll visit "Buchenwald" memorial, the largest German concentration camp memorial.

## BRUSSELS FIELD TRIP – INCLUSIVE

On our second weekend, we will be visiting Brussels. The Belgian capital city is often considered the de-facto capital of the European Union. Hence, we will visit the European Parliament, the largest and probably most important elected democratic institution. Also, we will explore the manifold districts of the city of Brussels including all its important sites in a city tour by bus. Furthermore, we will visit a law office in Brussel in close thematic coordination with your courses. On our way back to Giessen we will stop by the fairytale-like castle "Schloss Drachenburg."

## RHINE VALLEY DAY TRIP

We offer an optional day trip to the Rhine Valley. The Rhine Valley is one of Germany's most beautiful landscapes. After hiking and a boat trip on the Rhine River, you will enjoy a wine tasting with some regional German delicacies.

During your stay, we offer a number of social events, e.g. we offer a city rally, a sports day and a campus summer party. These events offer you the unique opportunity to get in contact with the other students and find friends for life.
